### **21/01836/FUL - Whinney Hills Appleton Road**

At a meeting of the Parish Council on 13 September 2021 it was resolved:

#### **C We do not object but wish to make comments or seek safeguards**

Appleton Road is an unrestricted road subject to the national speed limit, and the council is concerned about slow moving traffic entering and exiting the site and encountering fast moving traffic on the main carriageway.

We would ask that the following safeguards be sought when considering the application.

1. That the appropriate visibility splay, approved by the Highways Authority, is created and maintained. There are numerous instances in the parish where hedges are not maintained in a timely manner that creates visibility issues for vehicles particularly at junctions.
2. That time gaps between bookings is mandated, as per the covering letter, such that only one customer is leaving or entering the site at any given time, and that usage is 'low key'.
